## SCHEDULED SPRAY AREAS FOR ADULT MOSQUITO CONTROL

(STOCKTON, CA) – In response to increased adult mosquito populations and the detection of West Nile virus in several areas of San Joaquin County, the San Joaquin County Mosquito and Vector Control District (District) is preparing to conduct adult mosquito control operations.

The District will continue to implement the California Mosquito-Borne Virus Surveillance and Response Plan to protect the public health and welfare. Spray locations and times will normally be available 24 hours in advance. **People can access spray information and spray schedules by calling the District at (209) 982-4675 or toll-free at 1-800-300-4675 during business hours from 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 12:30 p.m. to 3:30 a.m., Monday through Friday or by visiting the District's website online at [www.sjmosquito.org](http://www.sjmosquito.org).**

Due to increased adult mosquito populations and/or detection of West Nile virus, the following areas are scheduled for spraying:

**Ground spraying for adult mosquito control using MGK Pyrocyde 7396 or Evergreen 60-6 is scheduled for the evening of Thursday July 22, 2010, between 8:00 p.m. – 12:00 a.m. or the morning of Friday July 23, 2010 between 4:00 a.m. – 6:00 a.m. (see attached maps for approximate locations).**

- **Spanos Golf Course Area – (Bishop Tract)** > North to Telephone Cut, > South to Eight Mile Rd., > East to I-5, > West to Ten Mile Slough
- **Oak Grove Regional Park - Stockton.**
- **Brookside – Stockton** > North to Fourteen Mile Slough, > South to March Ln., > East to Feather River Dr., > West to Ten Mile Slough
- **Mountain House East** > North to Byron Rd., > South to W. Grant Line Rd., > East to Hansen Rd., > West to Mountain House Parkway

## SCHEDULED SPRAY AREAS FOR ADULT MOSQUITO CONTROL (Cont.)

**Aerial spraying** for adult mosquito control using Evergreen 60-6 is scheduled for the evening of Thursday, July 22, 2010, between 7:30 p.m. – 12:00 a.m. or the morning of Friday July 23, 2010 between 5:00 a.m. – 7:00 a.m.

- **Wright / Elmwood Tract (Delta area west of I-5)**
- **Rindge Tract – (Delta area west of I-5)**

Spraying for adult mosquitoes is done near sunset or sunrise with trucks and airplanes when mosquitoes are most active. The District will be using sprayers that apply a very fine mist of material that kills adult mosquitoes on contact. Control operations are contingent upon favorable weather conditions and if canceled, will **typically be rescheduled to the following morning or evening.**

**2010 update on West Nile virus activity for San Joaquin County: 2 dead birds, 6 mosquito samples, 0 horses and 0 sentinel chickens have test West Nile virus positive.**
